The choirs rehearse weekly with a professional choir leader and share stories, challenges and dreams. Each choir performs regularly at conferences, concerts, festivals and special events. There are 12 programs currently operating in Victoria with another two commencing in 2011. Plans are under way for programs in other parts of Australia.
